

Guidelines for Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel Conduct

(so that all may adore our Lord without distraction)

- 1) Because the Eucharist is exposed, genuflect on two knees upon entering the Lord's presence. (If unable to genuflect, please reverently bow.)
- 2) Be mindful of proper respectful attire.
- 3) Greet fellow adorers with a smile or quiet hello, then spend your hour in reverent silence.
- 4) No spontaneous, unscheduled events or sermonizing is allowed (unless approved by the pastor).
- 5) Never eat, drink, or chew gum in the chapel.
- 6) No playing of music or the use of speakers. Cell phones should be silenced.
- 7) Do not leave items in the chapel.

In case of inclement weather:

- Tornado/severe storm sirens ring
 - There is blessed cover in a box on a table inside the chapel. You may cover the Blessed Sacrament and seek shelter in the basement of the church.
- Snow/ice winter storm
 - If an adorer doesn't show and the weather requires you to return home, you may cover the Blessed Sacrament
 - If you arrive and the Blessed Sacrament is covered, you should uncover it and begin your hour of adoration
